If your department orders a new piece of equipment, please notify BioMed at **957-0769**. Please schedule a time that the BioMed technician can inspect the equipment **PRIOR TO USE**.

When entering a work order, please be sure to include the following information:

- **What** piece of equipment is not working
- **Who** can be contacted for additional information
- **Where** is the piece of equipment located
- **When** did it stop working?
When do you need it by? How long has it not been working?
- **Why:** What about it is not working? (Does it not turn on? Does it read low? Does it beep?)
